Precautions & Regulations

Fly Legacy is taking many precautions and implementing temporary changes, which are the following:

- Masks are required in the building and airport
- Aircraft keys are taken from holding shelf by instructors/renters
- Flights are checked out and in by instructors and renters
- Pilots call Atlantic themselves for fuel at 215-698-3100
- Social distancing is mandatory in the building
- Surfaces in the building and aircraft are to be continuously wiped
- Cleaning sanitizers are kept in the airplanes
- Masks, gloves and sanitizers are available at the front desk

- Temperature check for students via an infrared thermometer is provided
- Both instructors and students are to ask the COVID-19 symptom questions
- An electrostatic and HEPA air purifier is running
- Only credit cards and checks are taken for contactless payment, or cash over \$500 to be put directly onto student/renter accounts.
