1. Why is the pitot tube found on the left wing of a single engine aircraft?

GENE'S AVIATION TRIVIA ANSWERS

1. There is no definitive answer, but it is believed to be placed there so it is out the slipstream of the propeller which rotates clockwise.
2. It's a bar used to deploy something. Like the flap level on a Cherokee.
3. Non-vaporized fuel gases can turn into ice crystals and may cause ice to form in the carburetor.
4. A weather radar display which gives a constant horizontal cross-section of data at a constant altitude, sometimes known as CAPPI.
5. It is a compromise between passenger comfort and placing too much stress on the aircraft's fuselage.

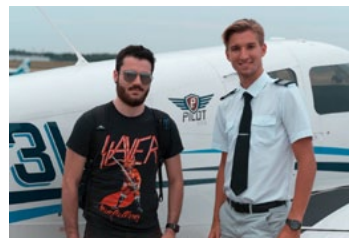

American Airlines Bonuses

American Airlines regional airline, Envoy, along with PSA, and Piedmont are offering up to \$150,000 in bonuses to pilots. The 15,000 employee, Fort-Worth based company is facing the effects of the hiring push within the aviation industry.
