GENE'S AVIATION QUIZ ANSWERS

- 1 It indicates FSS frequency of 122.2 is available.
- 2 It is a VFR military training route. Jets flying at 1500 AGL or lower in excess of 300mph. There is one slightly north of Cape May airport.
- 3 The population is greater than 250,000.
- 4 A VFR corridor in a Class B airspace. Still need a clearance.
- 5 No. A closed pattern means you can continue in the pattern as long as you want without communications unless the tower changes the clearance or you make a change.
