GENE'S AVIATION QUIZ ANSWERS

• They are old style markers for helicopter aiming points

A tube placed on the side of an aircraft to a create a low-pressure area where the gyro instruments can use the suction to spin the gyroscopes

I flight level is an aircraft's altitude at standard air pressure. Altitude is the vertical distance measured from mean sea level One of the gear does not go up, the plane is not airworthy, and you need a Ferry Permit to fly it back to get repairs.

• Only the owner, or an agent of the owner like a mechanic, who can solicit the ferry permit on the owner's behalf if the owner supplies a signed letter of authorization.
