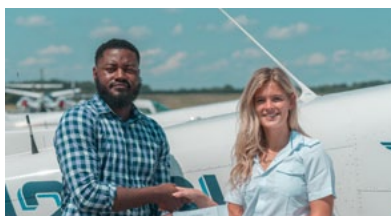

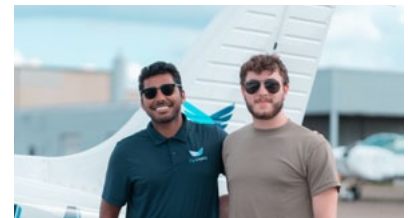

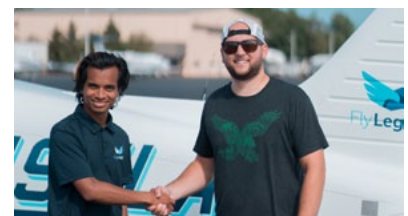

GENE'S AVIATION QUIZ ANSWERS

- 1 They are old style markers for helicopter aiming points
- 2 A tube placed on the side of an aircraft to create a low-pressure area where the gyro instruments can use the suction to spin the gyroscopes
- 3 A flight level is an aircraft's altitude at standard air pressure. Altitude is the vertical distance measured from mean sea level
- 4 No. If the gear does not go up, the plane is not airworthy, and you need a Ferry Permit to fly it back to get repairs.
- 5 Only the owner, or an agent of the owner like a mechanic, who can solicit the ferry permit on the owner's behalf if the owner supplies a signed letter of authorization.
