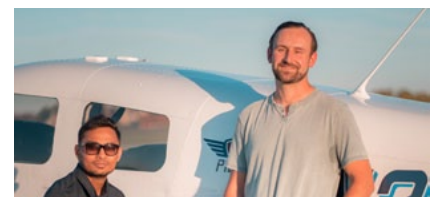

GENE'S AVIATION QUIZ ANSWERS

- 1 No, your takeoffs and landings need to be performed in an aircraft with the same category, class, and type.
- 2 They are cumulus clouds with cirrus clouds on top, they have a flat top. They look like a mushroom.
- 3 It is precipitation from a nimbostratus cloud that evaporates before reaching the ground.
- 4 100 feet wide. 12 stripes would be 150 feet wide.
- 5 Vfe is the maximum flap extended speed, it's the top of the white arc. Some aircraft allow partial flap extension above Vfe, always check your POH.
- 6 The same, but your ground speed is slower.
