GENE'S QUIZ ANSWERS

- There is special use airspace not consistent with Part 91. You need to refer to Part 93.
- Inhe white cutouts are inserted to allow those sections to be easily seen on the chart.
- No, only public use airports do so. Private (restricted ones) do not list different traffic patterns. Right hand traffic patterns are not listed at airports with full time control tower operations.
- Aerodrome Flight Information Service. Conducts continuous visual observations at the airport and in its vicinity, including the observation of aircraft, vehicles, machinery and equipment, people on the ground movement field and current meteorological conditions, and transmits that information by radio.
- It has a muted tan color. Indicates something special is going on in this area. In this case, a Part 93 Flight Restricted Zone.
